



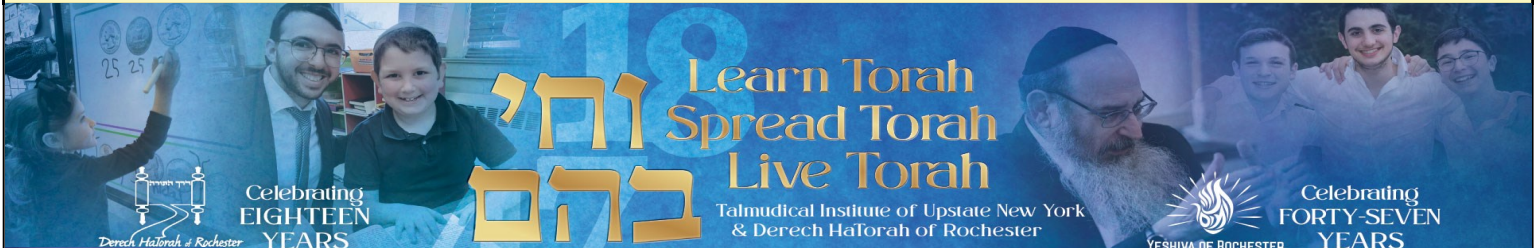

From the Principal

Parents in Texas are mourning their children due to another horrifying school shooting. While we daven that such unspeakable evil should never happen in our community, we must also do everything in our power to protect our innocent children and dedicated staff.

Therefore, with the generous support of the Dan family and thanks to successfully qualifying for another round of NYS's Anti-Hate Crime grant, we've continued to significantly upgrade our school's security. Specifically, we are adding additional cameras to get us up to 100% footprint coverage of our entire building and grounds. Our sliding entry gate, which will block both vehicular and walking access to the property, is slated to be finished within the next week to 10 days. We have also installed brand new entry doors made of reinforced steel that are bullet-resistant. This summer, we will be replacing the last group of windows so that all of our windows are bullet resistant and shatter-proof. Additionally, all of the old classroom doors were replaced and they can now lock from the inside. Additionally, if you've been on our property recently, you probably noticed that our campus is now fully fenced-in and has bollards (barriers to prevent cars or trucks from breaking through) all around the property. Our two-way radio system is used daily during recess and outdoor activities to allow for emergency communication. We are also appreciative of the Greece police department's quick response time. We have provided all police cars in the department with fobs to allow them immediate access into our building. We have also set up the security system so that only the main entry door is used; all other doors remain locked and we are alerted via an alarm in the office when another door is used. Finally, our faculty and staff recently completed more training with NYS troopers and Mark Henderson, Director of ROC Strong Community Security, specifically on lockdowns.

Our priority is to keep every one of these precious children safe and happy. We will continue doing everything possible to ensure their safety.

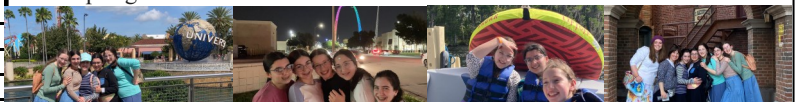
