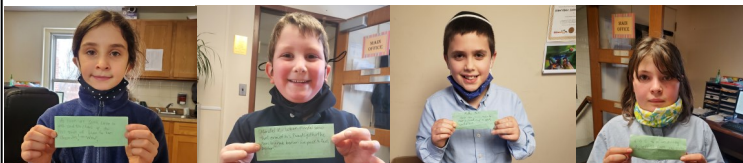

Introducing the Metzuyanim Honor Roll! We are very excited to formalize this special system to honor and recognize our students' academic success. We are hopeful that all of our 4th through 8th graders will strive to earn this prestigious honor.

While some students are very intrinsically self-motivated, the purpose of this program is to introduce another dimension of motivation for the rest of our students to develop good study skills, and become more serious about learning and review. The incentive of earning a spot on the Metzuyanim Honor Roll will encourage students to become more diligent and responsible and will recognize them for a job well done!

DHR's Metzuyanim Honor Roll Details:

- If a student has achieved academic excellence (all grades above 80%) and has behaved in a respectful way, as befitting a DHR student, then every Friday afternoon at lunchtime, that student picks up and fill out a Student Submission Form and puts it into the submission box located in the DHR office.
- The forms will then be compiled into a list and all applicable teachers will confirm that each student qualifies for a place on that week's Metzuyanim Honor Roll.
- Students who have earned Metzuyanim Honor Roll status on **all** qualifying weeks of that month will participate in a very special monthly celebration/event/reward within the first few days of the next month.
- This program starts this Monday, January 4 and the first month runs throughout January 2021.
