## Middos Program!

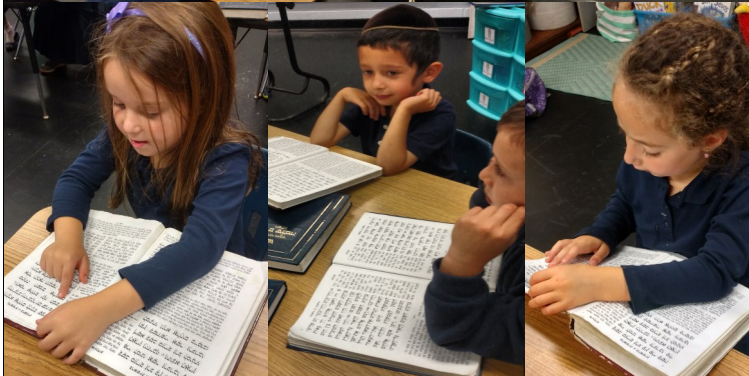
We are so excited to share with you the wonderful news about our Middos Program this year!

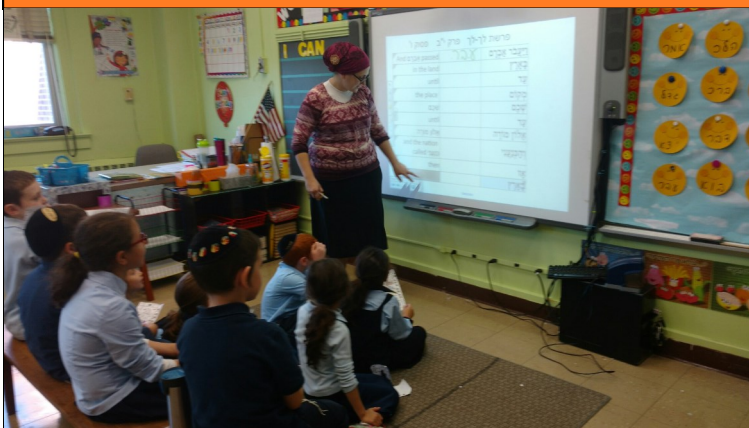
