Former Brighton Police Chief Mark Henderson, now the Jewish Community Federation's Community Security Coordinator, did a Safety and Active Shooter training workshop with our faculty last week. The purpose of the valuable training was to prepare DHR staff to react quickly and confidently in emergency situations. Then, on Wednesday, he visited our building again with vendors to get quotes on a PA system.

Last year, we were awarded a major grant to install a perimeter fence, shatterproof ground and first floor windows, a keyfob entry system and additional security cameras. We are actively working on procuring funding from other sources for important additional security updates.

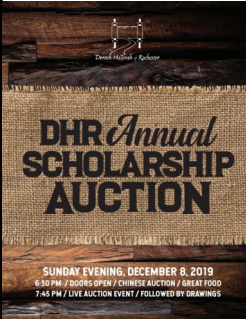
Middos Menchen Stars of the Week
