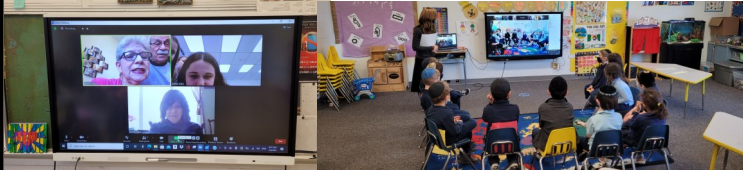


Virtual Grandparents Day

It's happening soon!! On Tuesday morning, our incredible, record-breaking MILLION DOLLAR campaign kicks off...and we hope that every one of you will be a part of it!!

Whether you are a TIUNY and/or DHR alumnus, a current or former DHR and/or TIUNY parent, or a proud supporter of our schools, we need your help.

Some of you have taken on teams to encourage and motivate others to give (we already have 77 teams signed up – and it's not too late!). Some will donate personally...but we encourage all of you to get involved.

Join with DHR and the Yeshiva to advance community, continuity, and outstanding scholarship. Next week, we will all have the opportunity to strengthen the only Kindergarten through Kollel school system in upstate New York.

WHEN:

The campaign kicks off on Tuesday, May 11th at 10am and ends Wednesday, May 12th at 10pm.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

Initially, we are approaching potential "matchers" - key members of our community and our alumni families to pledge at least \$10,000 each – for a combined total of \$666,666. Our overall target for our fundraiser is \$1,000,000, which we will accomplish by raising an additional \$333,334 during the campaign when every donation will be "matched" – actually tripled!!!!

So, for just 36 hours, any funds donated will be tripled by our matchers! For example, if you donate \$1,000, it will show up as \$3,000! Wow!! What an impact!
