Middos Menchen Stars of the Week

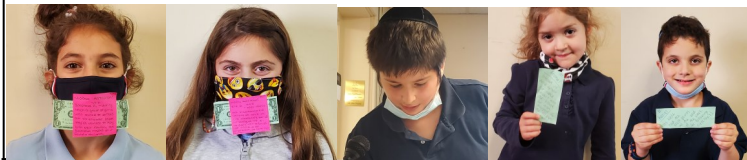
Raziel (1st grade) - His table had the most points at the end of the week. Great job following directions!

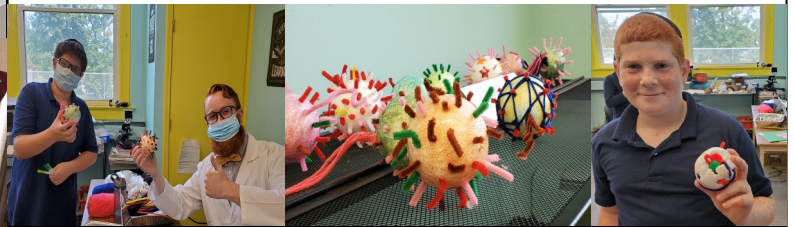
From the Principal
