~ Baruch Dayan HaEmes. This week, the world lost a Torah giant. **Harav Hagoan Dovid Feinstein, Zt"l**, was a paragon of humility and a Torah genius. "Reb Dovid", as he was fondly called, was the leading posek, authority on Jewish law, in America. At the funeral in front of his Yeshiva, MTJ, his greatness was described, but also of note, according to Rav Ganzweig, the Yeshiva's mashgiach, was "the way he interacted with people, regardless of whether they were rich or poor, wise or foolish, talmid chacham or not learned, great or small; all were recipients of his endless chessed and kindness". All of klal Yisrael will miss his warmth and accessibility, as well as his great wisdom and leadership.

This week, many also mourned the loss of the former Chief Rabbi of the UK, **Rabbi Lord Jonathan Sacks**. Rabbi Sacks, Chief Rabbi of the United Kingdom for 22 years, was an eloquent teacher and spokesman for Orthodox Jewry.
